EXTREME WATER CONSERVATION REQUIRED

The town's raw water pipe that supplies water to the drinking water treatment plant has broken in several locations. Scotia Community Services District (CSD) and Town of Scotia Company LLC are actively working to determine the cause and perform emergency repairs. There is no estimated time when the system will be up and running again. All industrial water users have been notified and have ceased use of the treated and raw water.

At this point, you ***do not*** need to boil your water; however, it is imperative that water be conserve until a permanent solution to the problem has been implemented. As an interim measure, we are working on having treated water hauled to our treated water storage tank.

Until further notice, please make every effort to conserve water, so the town does not run out and depressurize our drinking water distribution system. At a bare minimum,

DO NOT:

water lawns, irrigate, wash cars, or otherwise use large amounts of water.

Use water ***only*** for necessary purposes such as drinking, cooking, and showering.
