a. Rio Dell Fire Protection District Annexation follow-up

- Annexation of Scotia into Rio Dell's fire jurisdiction was introduced by Humboldt LAFCo and the Rio Dell Fire Protection District at the regularly scheduled meeting in October (2019).
- Each parcel can expect to have approximately \$100 assessed on the annual property taxes issued by the County of Humboldt.
- The services of Rio Dell Fire Protection District will lower (improving) the Insurance Service Office (ISO) rating for Scotia homeowners potentially lowing home insurance rates.

- Updates given on the corridor project (sitting at 90% completion)
- Easement on HRCs property at the Block Building (to accommodate a back-up generator for the river pumps) is still in the works.
- Three (3) companies have been solicited for quotes from companies for the purchase of a generator.
- A bypass valve is to be installed on Million Gallon tank in order to save costs on polymer.
- Each tote costs roughly \$3,500 and the bypass valve should reduce the need for as much polymer.
- The annual Filter inspection for the Water Treatment Plant is in the scope of annual services with SHN. Staff will be looking into the possibility of completing the work in house if the State Water Resource Control Board will allow the job to be completed not by an engineer.
- The SCSD Water Ordinance and the Master Fee Schedule are being updated to be compliant with SB 98 and will be brought to the Board at the December meeting.
