RESOLUTION NO. 2023-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCOTIA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS ACCEPTING A QUITCLAIM DEED FROM THE TOWN OF SCOTIA, LLC TRANSFERRING RIGHTS AND INTEREST IN A RESERVE EASEMENT PERTAINING TO UTILITY INFRASTRUCTURE RUNNING BELOW HIGHWAY 101

WHEREAS, on June 5, 1972, the Pacific Lumber Company deeded real property to the State of California in furtherance of the construction of State Highway 101; reserving for itself, its successors or assigns the right to install, replace, repair, remove and maintain water pipelines transversely under the State highway, hereafter Asset, the "Easement;" and

WHEREAS, a certain written Transfer Agreement, dated April 27, 2017, between the Town of Scotia, LLC ("TOS") and Scotia Community Services Agreement ("SCSD") was executed to facilitate the TOS' transfer its rights and interest in certain infrastructure for water and wastewater lines, pipes storm drains, distribution and collection systems, streets and street lighting, to the SCSD; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the April 27, 2017 Asset Transfer Agreement, the Board of Directors also has before it a Resolution to accept an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication of certain Utility Corridor Infrastructure from the TOS, including aforementioned utility infrastructure located within the Easement; and

WHEREAS, the TOS desires to transfer its rights and interest in the Easement by way of Quitclaim Deed, as attached hereto as Exhibit A, to the SCSD in furtherance of the transfer of Utility Corridor Infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the SCSD to accept the Easement in furtherance of its access, monitoring, control, maintenance, and repair of the utility infrastructure located within the Easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Scotia Community Services District as follows:

- 1. The Recitals set forth above and the attached Exhibit A attached hereto are incorporated herein and made an operative part of this Resolution.
- 2. The SCSD hereby accepts the Quitclaim Deed from the TOS, as more fully set forth and described in the attached Exhibit A, and the President of the Board of Directors is authorized to execute said deed.
- 3. The SCSD Board Clerk shall certify the adoption of this resolution, shall cause a certified resolution to be filed in the District Office, and shall cause the Easement Quitclaim Deed with an executed Certificate of Acceptance to be recorded in the Humboldt County Recorder's Office.
- 4. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
